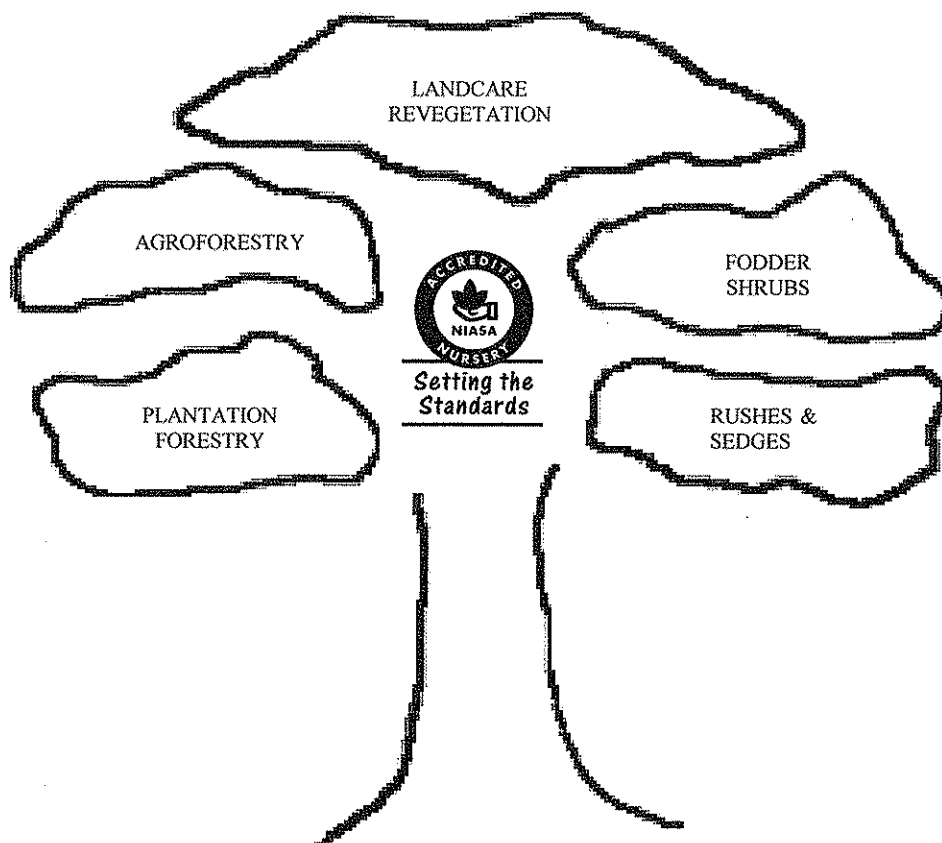

<i>Acacia rostellifera</i> Summer-scented Wattle	Flowers Oct - Dec. Grows in dense thickets. Spreads rapidly by means of suckers.		3 - 6	moist, well drained, dry, limestone
<i>Acacia saligna</i> Golden Wreath Wattle	Hardy, easily grown shrub or small tree. Suitable for fodder. Flowers in spring.	400	3 - 5	sand, loam, clay, saline, waterlogged
<i>Agonis flexuosa</i> WA Peppermint	Tree with pendulous foliage. Coastal and windy conditions. Flowers - spring	650	8 - 10	sand or gravel
<i>Allocasuarina huegeliana</i> Rock Oak	Upright tree. Semi-pendulous foliage.	250	8 - 15	sand, gravel
<i>Allocasuarina lehmanniana</i> Dwarf Sheoak	Bushy shrub. Fast growing.	400	1.5	sand, gravel, semi-saline
<i>Anigozanthos flavidus</i> Kangaroo Paw	Vigorous clumping plant. Tall spikes of yellow/greenish flowers in summer.		1	moist, well drained, limestone
<i>Astartea fascicularis</i>	Dark green upright shrub. Pink/White flowers - spring.	400	2	wet, swampy, sand
<i>Beaufortia sparsa</i> Swamp Bottlebrush	Orange flowers in autumn. Cut flowers.	600	1 - 2	acid sand, swampy
<i>Callistemon glauca</i> (<i>speciosus</i>) Albany Bottlebrush	Upright dark green shrub. Large red flowers in spring.	650	4	wet, swampy, clay, peat
<i>Callistemon phoeniceus</i> Fiery Bottlebrush	Spreading shrub. Bright red flowers in spring.	350	2 - 3	moist soils incl. Saline wet clay
<i>Calothamnus quadrifidus</i> Granite Bottlebrush	Low spreading shrub. Red flowers - good bird habitat.	350	3	sand, gravel, loam
<i>Calothamnus rupestris</i> Granite Netbush	Small spreading shrub. Bright red flowers in autumn.	450	2 - 3	sand, gravel, loam
<i>Calothamnus sanguineus</i> Fiery Netbush	Small spreading shrub. Bright red flowers in autumn.	450	2 - 3	sand, gravel, loam
<i>Casuarina obesa</i> Swamp Sheoak	Upright bushy tree. Will sucker to form dense thickets. Excellent timber	250	8 - 12	clay, loam, gravel, saline, waterlogged.

<i>Corymbia (Eucalyptus) calophylla</i> Marri or Red Gum	Hardy large tree. Flowers - autumn	500	15 - 30	sand, gravel
<i>Corymbia ficifolia</i> <i>Red flowering Gum</i>	Dense foliage. Large clusters of orange or red flowers. Flowers - autumn	700	7 - 15	sand, gravel
<i>Corymbia (Eucalyptus) maculata</i> Spotted Gum	Adaptable, elegant. Large canopy. Excellent timber. Flowers winter - spring.	500	20 - 30	loam, clay
<i>Eucalyptus botryoides</i> Southern Mahogany or Bangalay	Heavily foliated upright tree. Fast. Versatile and adaptable. Flowers -autumn. First class timber.	400	15 - 20	sand, loam, acid or alkaline, waterlogged slightly saline.
<i>Eucalyptus camaldulensis</i> River Red Gum	Fast growing large tree. Adaptable. Excellent timber. Flowers - anytime	200	15 - 25	clay, loam, waterlogged, saline
<i>Eucalyptus cornuta</i> Yate or Hill Yate	Large erect tree. Rough dark bark. Flowers summer - autumn	650	10 - 25	clay, loam, waterlogged, slightly saline
<i>Eucalyptus decipiens</i> Moit	Small tree. Spreading crown. Creamy flowers in spring - summer	400	4 - 10	sand, gravel, clay
<i>Eucalyptus diversicolor</i> Karri	Tall, erect tree. Adaptable. Flowers spring - summer	650	20 - 30	sand, loam, gravel
<i>Eucalyptus globulus ssp. globulus</i> Tasmanian Blue Gum	Fast, erect tree. Seed selected for high performance, high yield pulp. Flowers winter - spring.	500	20 - 30	sand, gravel acid or alkaline
<i>Eucalyptus globulus var. compacta</i> Compact Tassie Blue Gum	Short-trunked tree. Small branches from the base. Dense conical tree. Flowers - winter. Good shelter belt trees.	600	15 - 20	sand, loam, gravel
<i>Eucalyptus gomphocephala</i> Tuart	Large, dense, bushy. Fast, adaptable. Flowers - autumn	400	20 - 30	sand, gravel, acid or alkaline
<i>Eucalyptus grandis</i> Rose Gum	Very fast upright tee. Dark green spreading canopy. Flowers - winter.	650	20 - 40	loam, clay, waterlogged
<i>Eucalyptus lehmannii</i> Bushy Yate	Dense, bushy tree or mallee. Flowers - winter.	450	4 - 10	sand, gravel
<i>Eucalyptus leucoxylon ssp. megalocarpa</i> Large-fruited Pink-flowered Gum	Dense, bushy, coastal, windy. Flowers autumn - winter.	400	8 - 10	gravel, loam, clay
<i>Eucalyptus marginata</i> Jarra	Tall, upright, rough bark. Excellent timber. Flowers - spring.	600	15 - 20	gravel, sand, loam
<i>Eucalyptus occidentalis</i> Swamp or Flat-topped Yate	Hardy, adaptable, fast. Tolerates wide range of conditions. Flowers autumn - winter.	300	12 - 20	loam, clay, waterlogged, saline.

<i>Eucalyptus patens</i> WA Blackbutt or Yarri	Blue/grey foliage, pendulous, rough bark. Flowers - spring.	600	10 - 25	loam, gravel, waterlogged.
<i>Eucalyptus platypus. var. heterophylla (utilis)</i> Coastal Moort	Bushy, dense, fast, adaptable. Flowers - summer	300	3 - 6	sand, gravel, loam
<i>Eucalyptus preissiana</i> Bell-fruited Mallee	Spreading shrub, large glossy leaves. Large yellow flowers in winter.	400	3	gravel, loam, rocky
<i>Eucalyptus rudis</i> WA Flooded Gum/Blue or River Gum	Upright, fast, rough grey bark. Flowers - spring.	600	15 - 25	Loam, sand, gravel, slightly saline, waterlogged.
<i>Eucalyptus saligna</i> Sydney Blue Gum	Fast, tall, upright. Glossy leaves, smooth, pinkish bark. Flowers summer - autumn	700	25 - 30	loam, gravel
<i>Eucalyptus spathulata</i> Swamp Mallet	Upright branches, spreading crown. Fine leaves, smooth coppery bark. Hardy. Flowers spring - winter	300	8 - 12	gravel, clay, water logged, saline
<i>Eucalyptus wandoo</i> Wandoo or White Gum	Hardy, upright, smooth white bark. Durable tough timber. Flowers - autumn.	300	15 - 25	gravel, loam, clay
<i>Hakea corymbosa</i> Cauliflower Hakea	Large, many branched spreading shrub with smooth grey bark. Creamy yellow flowers with a greenish tinge.		2	well drained soils,
<i>Hakea laurina</i> Pin-cushion Hakea	Fast growing shrub, dense foliage. Red/cream spiky balls of flower in autumn.	300	3 - 5	sand, gravel, loam
<i>Hakea prostrata (inland upright)</i> Harsh Hakea	Shrub with spreading branchlets. Variable in form. Inland form tall open plant. Flowers sweetly scented white, creamy-white.			well drained soils,
<i>Hardenbergia comptoniana</i> Native Wisteria	Vigorous climber with purple/mauve flowers.			well drained soils,
<i>Kunzea baxteri</i> Granite Kunzea	Spreading shrub. Red bottlebrush flowers in winter.	400	2 - 3	sand, gravel, clay
<i>Kunzea ericifolia</i> Yellow Kunzea	Upright shrub. Cream flowers in spring.	500	2 - 3	sand, gravel
<i>Melaleuca brevifolia</i> Mallee Honey Myrtle	Bushy small tree. Dark green. White flowers in spring.	400	2 - 5	clay, gravel, saline, waterlogged
<i>Melaleuca cuticularis</i> Salt-water Paperbark	Hardy, spiky foliage. Flowers in spring.	500	6 - 12	clay, loam, waterlogged, saline

<i>Melaleuca densa</i> Lemon Honey Myrtle	Spreading shrub. Lemon flowers in winter - spring.	450	1 - 2	gravel, sand
<i>Melaleuca incana</i> <i>Grey Honey Myrtle</i>	Pendulous grey foliage. Yellow flowers in spring.	600	2 - 3	sand, acidic
<i>Melaleuca preissiana</i> Paperbark	Large spreading tree. Dense foliage, white flowers.	450	3	sand, clay, loam, saline
<i>Melaleuca raphiophylla</i> Swamp Paperbark	Bushy tree. White flowers in spring.	600	7 - 10	sand, waterlogged
<i>Melaleuca scabra</i>	Dwarf to small shrub, fine soft hairy foliage, gold-tipped pink to purple flowers in spring.		30 - 60cm	moist, well drained
<i>Melaleuca viminea</i>	Large bushy shrub or small tree. Bark fibrous. Flowers white or cream in spikes.		7	sand, limestone, well drained
<i>Pinus pinaster</i> Maritime Pine	Upright tree. Good windbreak. Drought tolerant.	400	15	sand, loam, gravel
<i>Pinus radiata</i>	Upright tall tree.	650	20	loam, gravel
<i>Regelia ciliata</i>	Small to medium spreading shrub, hairy grey-green ovate leaves, mauve brush flowers most of the year.		1 - 1.3m	moist well drained
<i>Sollya heterophylla</i> Australian Bluebell	Sturdy, shrubby twiner.			
<i>Taxandria linearifolia</i>	Flowers Mar-May/Sept-Dec		5	loam, clay, sand
<i>Taxandria parviceps</i> White Ti-tree	Upright shrub. Cut flowers for drying. Flowers - spring.	650	2 - 3	acid sand, swampy

Rushes & Sedges

<i>Baumea articulata</i> Jointed Twig Rush	Tall rush with jointed stems	550	2	fresh permanent swamps, sand, clay
<i>Baumea rubiginosa</i> River Twig Rush	Narrow strap-like foliage. Erect seedhead.	600	2	sand, clay, fresh, swampy.
<i>Carex appressa</i> Tall Sedge	Dark green, erect foliage. Large clumps.	600	2	creeks, swamps, slightly saline

<i>Carex fascicularis</i> Tassel Sedge	Prefers to grow under paperbarks. Green strap-like foliage.	700	1	peaty swamps
<i>Ficinia (Isolepis) nodosa</i> Knobby Club Rush	Forms large beds. Bright green thin stems. Hardy.	450	1	creeks, flats, sand, clay, semi-saline
<i>Juncus kraussii</i> Shore Rush	Clumping plant, forms large colonies. Good for habitat areas.	400	1.2	sand, clay, creeklines, semi-saline
<i>Juncus pallidus</i> Pale rush	Large clumps formed, holds sand together.	500	2	sand, peat, semi-saline creeks
<i>Meeboldina scariosus</i> Velvet Rush	Forms small clumps of erect foliage. Seedheads attractive coppery colour.	650	1.2	swamps, creeks
<i>Juncus subsecundus</i> <i>Finger Rush</i>	Tufted rush. Blue-Green stems	650	1	For pond edge or bog plant
<i>Juncus pauciflorus</i> <i>Loose-Flower rush</i>	Bright green arching tussock-red flowers	500	1	Wet conditions-Tolerates dry once established
